CALEDON OPP LAY CHARGES IN FRAUD INVESTIGATION

(CALEDON, ON) - Officers from the Caledon Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) have laid numerous charges following a fraud investigation.

On November 13, 2025, Caledon OPP received a report of a fraud involving a local minor hockey organization in the Town of Caledon. Police entered into an investigation which revealed donation funds intended for the organization were misappropriated.

As a result of the investigation, Frances BROWN, 45, of Brampton, was charged with:

- Mischief
- Fraud over \$5000
- Criminal breach of trust

The accused is scheduled to appear at the Ontario Court of Justice in Orangeville on December 18, 2025, to answer to the charges.

The OPP urges individuals and businesses to remain vigilant to instances of fraud.
